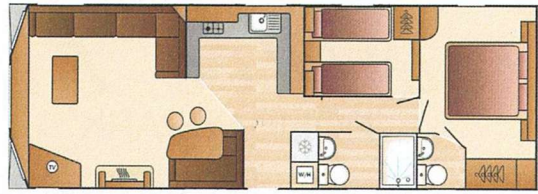
### Luxury Facilities are Standard at Trewince

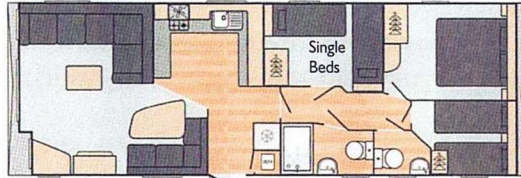

We supply pillows and duvets but we ask guests to provide sheets, pillowcases, duvet covers, towels and tea-towels.

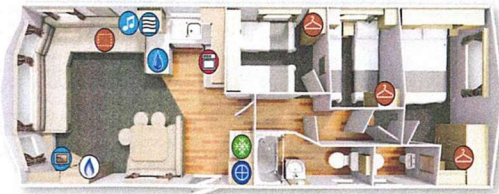
All of our accommodation is non-smoking and strictly pet free.



Burgundy 36x12 - 2 Bed



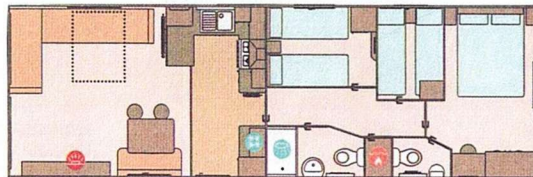
Burgundy 36x12 - 3 Bed



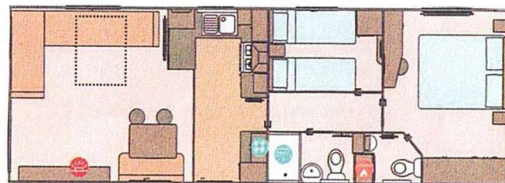
Rio Gold 37x12 - 3 Bed
